









Design your own Easter egg

Monkey Puzzle's Chocolate Easter Nests Recipe

Who doesn't love making cakes AND eating them! Try out our favourite recipe this Easter and be sure to send us pictures of before, during and after- we'd love to see what you've made.

INGREDIENTS

- 225g/8oz plain chocolate, broken into pieces
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 50g/2oz butter
- 75g/2oz cornflakes
- Mini chocolate eggs



METHOD


- 1 Line a 12-hole fairy cake tin with paper cases.
- 2 Melt the chocolate, golden syrup and butter in a bowl set over a saucepan of gently simmering water (do not let the base of the bowl touch the water). Stir the mixture until smooth.
- 3 Remove the bowl from the heat and gently stir in the cornflakes until all of the cereal is coated in the chocolate.
- 4 Divide the mixture between the paper cases and press 3 chocolate eggs into the centre of each nest. Chill in the fridge for 1 hour, or until completely set.


RECIPE TIPS

Shredded wheat or puffed rice cereals can be used instead of the cornflakes


















Can you find the monkeys?


Five Little Bunnies



One hopped away and then there were two.














Two little bunny rabbits enjoying the sun,

One hopped away and then there was one.







He hopped away and then there were none!











Match the Easter eggs


Sleeping Bunnies - Lyrics
